hat is the secret to receiving God's strength and power? How do we go from lives that are full of weakness and fear, to lives that are filled with the confidence of God's favor and blessing?

One of the most important aspects of this transformation is time with God and His Word. The Bible tells us that those who know God will do great exploits (see Daniel 11:32).

The more we know and understand who God is, how much He loves us, and all He desires to do for us and through us—the more we will experience the peace, strength and power that are available in Him.

This process can begin as simply as setting aside some time when we talk to God, think about His Word, and then ask Him to speak to our hearts. Too often we have one-way conversations with God. We present our lists of prayers and praises without ever giving Him the opportunity to speak into our lives.

Satan, the enemy of your soul, knows what a difference this time with God can make in your life. He will do all that he can to steal it from you. He may tell you that you are too busy, or too exhausted. Perhaps he has told you that you are not worthy to have time with your Father in heaven, that you will never change, and that God is tired of waiting. This is absolutely untrue. You can bind the power of Satan in your life. As a Christian, you can speak in the name of Jesus, in the authority you have in Christ, and silence the lies of the enemy.

Remember, our Father is full of mercy. He is always ready to forgive, always ready to restore. He has great plans for you. And, He desires to reveal those plans to you.

God wants to help you, to comfort you, to strengthen you and fill you with power. Come to Him now, meditate on these verses, and then be still before Him and ask Him to speak to you. He will reveal incredible things to you and you will find that you are no longer afraid, weak, defeated and hopeless. This is the amazing change that comes as we spend time in the presence of God.
